### More fixes for common lawn problems

RepairClinic.com shares tips for solving common lawn problems:

1. **Problem:** Brown, dead patches, round in shape and surrounded by healthy grass.

**Likely cause:** A dog has left territory markings.

**Possible solution:** Give those spots extra water during the lawn's weekly watering. These spots usually recover quickly.

2. **Problem:** Large, dry patches.

**Likely cause:** Large, dry patches are commonly caused by compacted soil due to heavy foot traffic and/or insufficient watering.

**Possible solution:** If you have a sprinkler system, check to make sure there are no clogged or broken components. It could be that water simply isn't reaching those areas and as a result, they are drying out. Deep saturation weekly will result in root growth and a healthier lawn. Also, annual aerating will improve water penetration in compacted soils.
